

MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT CHECKLIST

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SAFETY

Check for injuries and Call 911.
If able to move vehicle, move vehicle to side of road.
If unable to move vehicle, turn on hazards, put out flares, etc.
Wait in safe place and do not leave scene of accident
until Emergency Responders arrive.



AVOID CONFRONTATION

Be polite;
Do not admit liability;
Do not sign anything at the scene of accident.



COLLECT EVIDENCE

Take pictures of other vehicle(s) Driver(s) License(s), Registration(s)
and Insurance Card(s), damage to vehicle(s) including make, model
and license plate, and scene of accident. Get witness(es) full name(s),
address(es) and phone number(s), and address where accident occurred.



SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION

Even if you think you are okay.
Document any injuries with pictures and copies of medical records.

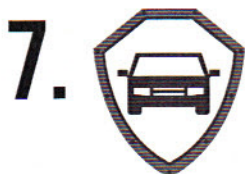


ORDER REPORTS

Order a copy of any Police, Ambulance and/or Fire Dept. report(s).



CONTACT AN ACCIDENT ATTORNEY



NOTIFY YOUR INSURANCE CARRIER, GET AN ESTIMATE OF ANY
PROPERTY DAMAGE AND FILE ANY NECESSARY FORMS
(including the MV-104 form due within 10 days after the accident if
fatality, personal injury or damage over \$1,000.00 to the property of
any one person), and No-Fault application, etc.
