Events: Three Events – 50 Targets Each Event
Participant may enter **any one, two or all** Events

Event 1: 12-yard Wobbles – 50 Targets

Event 2: 16-yard Wobbles – 50 Targets

Event 3: 21-yard Wobbles – 50 Targets

Special Targets: To increase Breast Cancer Awareness all Targets for this Meet will be **Prominent Pink** Birds. Standard Target – Stunning Color!

Lewis Awards: There will be an Automatic Lewis Pool for overall and an optional Lewis Pool for each event – see costs below. Lewis payouts will be improved so that 1st and 2nd place will each receive a full Lewis Share with payouts to the lower positions made in the normal manner. All Participants who tie for a Lewis Award will equally split the award for that payout class.

Cost: One Event - \$20 (includes cost of Automatic Lewis), add \$5 for Optional Event Lewis
Two Events - \$35 (incl. cost of Automatic Lewis), add \$10 for Optional Event Lewis
Three Events - \$50 (incl. cost of automatic Lewis), add \$15 for Optional Event Lewis
Shooting Fees of \$15 per event automatically go to Marshal Cancer Resource Center
