

VDOT ROAD PAVING PROJECT

Town of Middleburg Major Project Fact Sheet

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) has contracted with Superior Paving Corp. to repave most of the streets within the Town of Middleburg. They will also do a full-depth reconstruction (FDR) on the streets north of Route 50. This work began on August 20 and is expected to conclude by the end of September, weather permitting.

FDR is a pavement process that involves removing the existing asphalt, blending the underlying materials with cement to strengthen it and then placing a new layer of asphalt on top. FDR takes longer and can be more disruptive than regular maintenance; however, it will increase the strength, durability and service life of the roads.

During the project, NO PARKING signs will be posted in advance of the work in certain areas. Motorists are asked to observe any such signs. The contractor will work with residents and businesses to maintain access to properties; however, there may be brief periods while work is being performed in front of a property when access may be limited. **PLEASE USE EXTREME CAUTION WHEN DRIVING THROUGH A WORK ZONE AND OBEY ANY DIRECTIONS PROVIDED BY THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PERSONNEL.**
