Ordinance No. 514

An Ordinance regulating the Keeping  
of Swine in the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Be it enacted by the mayor and  
councilmen of the city of Garnett, Kansas:  
Section I. It shall be unlawful for any  
~~person~~ persons to keep swine in the city  
of Garnett, Kansas, between April 1st.  
and October 1st; provided, however, that  
swine may be kept in said city between  
said dates, provided such swine are  
kept in clean and disinfected pens  
located not less than 250 feet from  
any dwelling house in said city.

Section 2. Any person or persons  
violating any provision of this ordinance  
shall <sup>on conviction</sup> be fined in a sum not less than  
\$5.00, nor more than \$25.00, and shall

pay the costs of prosecution, and be committed to the city prison until said fine and costs are fully paid x
