LOBBY

This group decorates the lobby so that the audience is captured the moment they enter the theater. Works with the director to develop the theme and helps acquire materials.

<u>SET PAINTING</u> The set is painted during the daytime on stage starting in early July. We have an Artistic Set Designer and she instructs volunteers on how to paint the set.

TECH. CREW

Local 31 Tech. Crew moves the scenery during dress rehearsals and performances. Crew members are needed the last full week of July and the full week of the show for rehearsals. Anyone who would like to help out is welcome, but we ask that volunteers under the age of 12 are accompanied by an adult.

COSTUMES

This committee helps to organize the costumes and accessories for the cast. The ability to sew is not required - although sewers are greatly appreciated!!

PHOTOS

We need specific pictures taken of the cast early in the rehearsal period for the program. Anyone who enjoys photographing moving objects is encouraged to help.

CAST T-SHIRTS

This committee organizes and distributes Cast T-Shirts which have the production logo.

<u>HALL MONITORS ("Momiters & Pop-iters")</u> These parents are our "cast saints". They work backstage during dress rehearsals and performances to assure the safety of our crew and cast members. These parents are the "extra ears and eyes" we need so badly to make sure the show runs smoothly.

<u>SET CONSTRUCTION</u> The set is constructed every night on the stage from the beginning of rehearsals through the middle of July. Anyone who would like to help out is welcome, but we ask that volunteers under the age of 12 are accompanied by an adult.
