- Please do not wear perfume or strongly scented hair products.
- Jewelry should be minimal.

- Blue top is worn outside of black skirt
- Black panty hose or knee-highs (must come to knee, not ankle; no black socks)
- Black flats, no other colors or decorations
- Small stud earrings are appropriate; NO bracelets, necklaces or perfume
