SUMMERFIELD TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
November 8, 2021

The regular November meeting of the Summerfield Township Planning Commission was called to order on November 8, 2021, by Chairperson Amy Reiter at 7:00 pm.

a. Special Use for excavation on Ida West - The Summerfield Township Planning Commission reviewed the initial application for a proposed excavation site located on Ida West Road and being included in a 79.031 acre parcel number 5814-102-006-00. The site plan was to be taken to David Arthur for review and advice and perhaps to be further heard at public hearing at the regular December meeting.

a. Home Occupation for Christa Weston - The Summerfield Township Planning Commission next entertained the home occupation application of Christa Weston who desires to conduct a 12 child day care center in her home located at 560 Bragg Road, Deerfield, Michigan 49238. Being that all requirements have been met, Chairperson Amy Reiter moved to approve the application, Mark Strahan seconded and by unanimous approval the application will be recommended for approval by the Board.

b. Chairperson Amy Reiter next indicated to the Planning Commission that pursuant to statements made by Ron Garst at last month's meeting relative to restrictive excavation requirements, she notes that adjoining townships have similar restrictions and there not being a need to revisit.
