



## NEW IN, THE BEST OF BURGUNDY

De Vries Premium Wines is proud to welcome a new chapter in its fine wine portfolio: the distinguished Burgundy wines of the Boisset Collection. We begin this journey with two remarkable maisons—Jean-Claude Boisset and Bouchard Aîné & Fils.

Jean-Claude Boisset is a boutique winery located in a former 19th-century Ursuline convent. It focuses on single-vineyard expressions, natural fermentations, and restrained oak—hallmarks of contemporary Burgundian style. In contrast, Bouchard Aîné & Fils brings centuries of tradition as one of Burgundy's oldest négociants, producing classic wines from Bourgogne to village crus since 1750. These additions mark a significant expansion of our French range by adding one of the country's most important wine regions.


# THE FAMILLE PERRIN

*Pierre Perrin was a scientist who inherited Château de Beaucastel in 1909 from his father-in-law. Developing the estate into a vineyard was his vision but his son, Jacques, elevated his efforts until 1978 and brought worldwide recognition to the estate.*

*Jacques' contribution was significant by cementing three core values that his descendants still uphold today; absolute respect for land and terroir, biodynamic culture as a philosophy of life, and the research of truth, balance and elegance. Today, the torch is carried by Jacques' sons, Jean-Pierre and François. They are joined by the fifth generation of Perrins—Marc, Pierre, Thomas, Cécile, Charles, Matthieu, and César.*

# A Legacy of Winemaking Excellence

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*The Perrin family is one of the most respected names in French winemaking, with a proud heritage that spans five generations. Known for their balance of tradition, sustainability and innovation, they have shaped some of the Rhône Valley's most celebrated wines. They have also earned modern partnerships that combine wide appeal with serious winemaking—true to their core values.*



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## **A Family Rooted in Châteauneuf-du-Pape**

At the heart of the Perrin story is Château de Beaucastel, in the renowned Châteauneuf-du-Pape region of Southern Rhône. The estate entered the family in 1909 when Pierre Perrin, a scientist with a clear vision for its potential, inherited it from his father-in-law. He began the transformation of Beaucastel into a serious vineyard, and his son Jacques Perrin took that vision further—carrying it forward until 1978 and putting the estate firmly on the world map.

Jacques was far ahead of his time. In the 1950s, he introduced organic farming at a time when very few others were thinking that way. His sons Jean-Pierre and François took over in the 1970s and began applying biodynamic principles to their winemaking—deepening their connection with nature and land.

Today, Jean-Pierre and François work side by side with the fifth generations of Perrins – Marc, Pierre, Thomas, Cécile, Matthieu, César, and Charles. Each family member brings different strengths, and together they preserve the house philosophy while preparing for the future.

### **Philosophy**

Famille Perrin is now the leading organic wine producer of the Southern Rhône Valley, with access to some of the best terroirs in the region. Their approach is rooted in nature and tradition. They believe that only through organic viticulture, and close attention to the land, can true terroir be expressed. This belief runs through everything they do—from their vineyards to their winery to their gin distillery.

At Beaucastel, soils are studied carefully to keep them healthy and alive. That effort shows in the fruit—grapes that carry the energy of their place and produce expressive, balanced wines. The process supports the vine's natural resistance and enhances its vitality.

Their guiding idea is simple: the vine should be placed in its universe. In their untouched vineyard plots, bees, ladybugs, and birds share the environment in peace, creating a healthy, thriving ecosystem. Only 45

workers tend the estate full-time, preserving this harmony year-round.

Charles Perrin, now the custodian of Château de Beaucastel, says the philosophy goes beyond organic. It's about careful listening—understanding what each vine needs. For example, biodynamics works beautifully in the Southern Rhône, but in the North, they've learned to adapt, always guided by what the vines and the land are telling them.

This same thinking was behind the complete renovation of Château de Beaucastel's historic winery. Seven years ago, the family began rebuilding the 16th-century site from the ground up. They used sandstone from the vineyards for the walls, and designed the cellar to work in harmony with nature—using mistral winds and solar energy to cool the space. The vines still climb the walls, untouched.

### **Terroir**

Famille Perrin's deep knowledge of soil and place shines in every vineyard they touch. While they farm several sites across the Rhône, it's their understanding of Beaucastel's unique terroir that defines their excellence.

Beaucastel sits on a foundation of marine sandstone, covered by the famous rounded galet stones. These hold daytime heat and release it through the night, helping the grapes ripen fully. The region also receives plenty of rainfall and is swept by the powerful Mistral wind, which dries the vines and reduces disease. All of this supports their organic approach and gives the wines intensity, balance, and freshness.

For the Perrins, farming in tune with the soil, climate, and local flora and fauna isn't a trend—it's simply the way forward.

### **Winemaking**

#### ***Château de Beaucastel and Coudoulet de Beaucastel***

At Beaucastel, they grow and blend all 13 grape varieties allowed in Châteauneuf-du-Pape—on land fully certified organic by Ecocert. Each grape is hand-picked and sorted by variety. Fermentation is done separately, and then comes the blending—guided by experience and intuition passed down through

generations. It's this unique approach that gives Beaucastel its complexity, age-worthiness and signature style year after year.

Just outside the official Châteauneuf-du-Pape boundary, Coudoulet de Beaucastel—known as “Baby Beaucastel”—is made with the same techniques and care. It's a powerful yet accessible Côtes du Rhône Rouge.

Each grape plays a specific role in the blends. Grenache and Cinsault bring roundness, warmth and color. Mourvèdre and Syrah add backbone, aging potential and structure. Each wine reflects a balance between nature, tradition and human craft.

#### ***Famille Perrin Côtes du Rhône and CDP***

Beyond Beaucastel, the Perrins produce a wide range of wines under the Famille Perrin label. These include Côtes du Rhône and wines from Gigondas, Vinsobres and Vacqueyras. The style remains true: minimal intervention, respect for terroir and family-led winemaking. These wines are approachable, expressive and deliver excellent value—sharing the Perrin signature in every glass.

#### ***La Vieille Ferme***

La Vieille Ferme was created over 45 years ago by Jean-Pierre and François Perrin to make a straightforward, affordable Rhône wine. Using the same grapes and techniques as at Beaucastel, they succeeded in creating a wine with real character and everyday charm. What began as a direct mail wine for French households became a global hit—loved for its honesty and easy appeal. Red, white, rosé or sparkling, La Vieille Ferme offers quality that always surprises.

#### ***Miraval and The Gardener Gin***

In 2012, the Perrins partnered with actor Brad Pitt to develop Miraval in Provence. It quickly became a benchmark in luxury rosé—fresh, elegant, and now iconic. The vineyard's location, altitude and limestone soils give it a distinct refreshing character that's in constant demand.

In 2020, the collaboration deepened with Fleur de Miraval—an exclusive rosé Champagne created with the Péters family of the Côte des Blancs. Combining old-vine Chardonnay with a touch of Pinot Noir, the wine is aged

on lees and made in limited editions. It's the only Champagne house focused entirely on rosé.

Then in 2023, the team launched The Gardener Gin. Master distiller Tom Nichol came out of retirement to create it—using citrus and botanicals from the French Riviera. The result is an organic gin that blends tradition with new-world elegance, bottled with the same care as their wines.

### **Prestige, craftsmanship and exclusivity**

In the early 1990s, as global wine became more corporate, a group of family-run estates came together to protect their values. That group became the Primum Familiae Vini (PFV), or “Leading Wine Families.” Founded by Robert Drouhin and Miguel Torres, it includes twelve of the world’s top family wineries. Membership is by invitation only—and Famille Perrin is one of the youngest.

PFV celebrates not just great wines, but the legacy of independent family winemaking. Each year, members release a single bottle from their finest vintages. These are collected into just twelve hand-crafted Marsh Oak cases—among the rarest in the world. To top it off, allocation is on a strict first-come, first-served basis.

### **Focus on the Wine**

The Perrin–De Vries partnership began with a rosé. Miraval was the very first rosé listed by De Vries Premium Wines, and it was clear from the start that we shared a similar vision: to bring great wines to East Africa with the same seriousness as they are made. Our values aligned from day one—and our partnership has only deepened since.

From the sun-drenched stones of Châteauneuf-du-Pape to the soft hills of Provence and the chalky vineyards of Champagne, Famille Perrin continues to define what French wine can be. By blending deep heritage with creative thinking, they bring something rare to every bottle—authenticity, family spirit, and enduring quality.

## 10 Years of Raising the Bar in Fine Wine & Spirits

What began as a renewable energy and consulting firm founded by Sjouke de Vries and Joke Dijkstra 10 years ago has transformed into one of East Africa's leading premium wines and craft spirits importers.

The journey into wines started simply—Sjouke missed enjoying good wines at fair prices in Kenya. A conversation with Don Tooth of Vergelegen sparked the idea to import one of South Africa's most respected wines. That was the beginning. Over time, the portfolio grew to include world-class selections from the globe's most renowned producers. Today, De Vries Premium Wines operates across Kenya, Rwanda and is expanding into Uganda, Tanzania and the Seychelles.

From the start, the business has been driven by a love for quality and a desire to raise the bar for the region's wine and spirits culture. With a focus on hospitality, De Vries has carved out a distinct space in East Africa's premium drinks market, offering carefully selected wines, champagnes and spirits, each chosen for its excellence.

Since 2015, De Vries Premium Wines has earned a reputation for quality, serving high-end hotels, restaurants, retailers and private collectors who value a serious approach to wines and spirits.

By building a strong global network and staying committed to service, the company has helped shape the region's growing appreciation for fine wines and spirits. In that time, it has also weathered its share of challenges—COVID-19, shifting trade regulations, supply chain disruptions and economic slowdowns—while staying focused on quality and consistency.

At the heart of the company is the team. Every staff member is certified through the globally recognised Wines and Spirits Education Trust (WSET), offered by its sister company the Hospitality Competence Centre - East Africa (HCC-EA). HCC-EA also recently became the official hosting partner of the Court of Master Sommeliers, the global benchmark in hospitality training. In addition, team members have completed internships at leading wineries in South Africa and Europe. The ambition is clear: to become a team that stands out not only in East Africa, but on the world stage.

Together, Sjouke de Vries, Beverly Mbaika and Veronicah Wambugu form the leadership team—driving growth, vision and authenticity at every step.

As the company has grown, so has the need for space. Last year, the De Vries office relocated from Karen to Westlands, Nairobi, with sweeping views across the skyline. The move made room for something long envisioned: The Tasting Corner—a dedicated B2B tasting bar where clients can explore the full portfolio in an immersive setting.


The Tasting Corner was ready just in time for our 10-year anniversary, which we celebrated in style with our team, family and friends—great food, and even better wines.

# CHÂTEAU DE BEAUCASTEL

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Beaucastel grows and blends all 13 grape varieties authorized by the appellation, all of which are certified organic by Ecocert. Afterwards, the wine is stored in oak barrels where it ages for one year undisturbed. The wine matures slowly in Beaucastel' cellar until the moment is right to bottle and then kept at the Château for another year.

Fondly referred to as 'Baby Beaucastel', Coudoulet de Beaucastel is neighbouring to Château de Beaucastel. The Coudoulet Rouge has been Certified Organic Grapes (Ecocert) since 2016.

**Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge**  
Comes from 50 year old organically grown vines over 250 acres in one single plot at the north of the appellation.

**Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc**  
The production of white wine at Beaucastel is limited as there are only 17 acres of white vines planted. The main variety is Roussanne, representing 80% of the blend.



Famille Perrin's range of wines enable you to discover the richness of the Southern Rhône Valley. With the same expertise and the same passion as for Château de Beaucastel, the Famille Perrin way makes each wine unique: using organic and biodynamic approaches, mastering the art of blending, and bringing out the freshness of the Southern Rhône aromas.

## Côtes du Rhône Réserve

The Rouge is a blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre; the Blanc is made of Grenache Blanc, Viognier, Marsanne, and Roussane; and the Rosé is Cinsault, Syrah, Grenache, and Mourvèdre.

## Gigondas La Gille

The Gigondas vineyard is one of the most historic vineyards in the appellation. It lies between the plain and the Dentelles, with the richest area lying between the two. The vines from which this wine comes benefit from a flow of fresh air. The Grenache here retains a very beautiful suppleness and a very aromatic character without heaviness to make a very distinguished wine.





**Vacqueyras Les Christins**

Vacqueyras is a French wine Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée (AOC) in the southern Rhône wine region of France, along the banks of the River Ouvèze. The Grenache and Syrah vines are on very clayey soils and are averaging 50 years old. They are fleshy and juicy. The Blanc is a blend of Bourboulenc, Clairette Grenache from the ancient alluvial soil of Mindel which rest on yellow Helvetian sands and sandstones.

**Châteauneuf-du-Pape Les Sinards**

The Rouge comes from the younger vines at Château de Beaucastel. The blend is 70% Grenache, 15% Syrah, and 15% Mourvèdre which is matured in casks for a year before bottling. The Blanc is rare and comes from a 2.5 acre vineyard located with the clos around the historical Pope's palace. It is a blend of 70% Grenache Blanc and 30% Clairette.



# LA VIEILLE FERME

Also known as 'Chicken wine', La Vieille Ferme is young and revolutionary. The wines are fresh and fruity and ideal for everyday drinking. In 2018, the family introduced their own way of producing sparkling wines: Méthode Contemporaine. This new method captures CO2 and reintroduces it to specially selected still wines in a unique way just prior to bottling for very fine and consistent mousse.

**White:** Bourboulenc, Grenache Blanc, Ugni Blanc, and Vermentino blend that is fermented in 90% cement vats and 10% new oak barrels with lees stirring. The wine is then aged in stainless steel tanks.

**Rosé:** A Provençal-style pale pink rosé made from Cinsault, Grenache, and Syrah using the saignée method.

**Red:** An easy-drinking blend of Carignan, Cinsault, Grenache, and Syrah that is fermented in cement vats then aged for 10 months in large oak barrels and cement vats.

**Sparkling White:** A blanc de blancs made from Chardonnay planted on limestone soils.

**Sparkling Rosé:** A versatile sparkling rosé blended from Grenache, Cinsault, and Pinot Noir.



# MIRAVAL

The art of rosé. Here the savoir-faire of the Perrin family is united with Brad Pitt's artistic sensitivity. Miraval's land in Provence is organized into dry stone terraces and each vineyard located at an average altitude of 350 meters for perfect elevation. *Miraval was the first rosé to ever feature in the Wine Spectator top 100 for its exceptional taste.*

## Miraval

From the exceptional terroirs in Provence, the grapes are harvested exclusively in the morning and sorted twice before destemming. Pressurage is done directly for Cinsault, Grenache and Rolle while the Syrah is vinified partially using the "saignee" method. The wine is then placed in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats (95%) and in barrels (5%) with batonnage.

## Studio

Created as a tribute to the recording studio where Pink Floyd recorded 'the Wall', this wine symbolizes the spirit of Art de Vivre around the Mediterranean. Studio by Miraval is strongly influenced by the proximity of the Mediterranean Sea where salty soils give the wine a unique character and an almost iodized finish. The Cinsault and Tibouren in Stainless steel vats. The Grenache & Rolle are partially vinified in tanks.



## FLEUR DE MIRAVAL

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Fleur de Miraval Rosé Champagnes were created to fly in the face of convention whilst respecting ancestral know-how. Bringing their craftsmanship, passion and creativity to bottle took five years of research and tastings in the greatest discretion. Its inspiration came from a desire to innovate a rosé champagne that was both pure, complex and timeless, in which the blend would show young Pinot Noir mirroring the fresh profile of matured Chardonnay.

### Fleur de Miraval Exclusive Rosé

Also known as ER1, ER2 and ER3 to mark the different editions (releases), each one brings the intensity, delicacy and complexity of the Côte des Blancs grand crus.

### Petite Fleur

The youngest creation of the Champagne house. This cuvée has a lesser proportion of reserve wines than Exclusivement Rosé and the Pinot Noir was vinified as a red wine.
