

Rapunzels Ringlets ©

Class Description

Project Description:

Beauty, strength and complexity describe us all and this necklace. In this class you will receive 2 jigs to keep. The complex becomes simple when we use these to weave ringlets and a toggle clasp. Ringlets and clasp can be used to create this elegant necklace and many other ways including embellishing Viking knit and Kumihimo braid.

Skill level required: All skill levels and ages welcome!

Supplies:

- size 11 seed beads (at least 3 coordinating colors)
- Tila beads
- Long bugle beads
- 4 mm beads – metal or glass faceted
- 2 mm beads – metal
- 8 feet 24 gauge wire in copper, brass, or silver...

Tools:

- metal comb – 1 11/16 inches long by 1 7/16 inches wide with 15 teeth (Figure 1)
- quick set modeling clay or Rio Grande's Jett Sett or homemade clay which dries to very sturdy
- chain nose pliers
- round nose pliers
- fork
- wire cutter
- scissors
- size 11 needles
- 8 – 10 lb Fireline
- 6 inch ruler or measuring tape
- tape
- permanent marker
- microcrystalline wax

Time required for class: 3 hours – project will be easily completed outside of class.

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
