<p>Pre-K (Half-day)- Our Pre-K class is a half-day program (8:30 am-11:30 am). This program aims to work with students on effective communication, language, and social skills. <p>KinderPlus (Half-day)- Our Lower School Half-Day program (11:30 am-2:30 pm) is similar to our Lower School Full-Day classroom. We noticed a need for a half-day classroom for some students as it is ideal for those students who receive ABA therapy. <p>Lower School (Full Day)- Our Lower School Full Day classroom (8:30 am-2:30 pm) focuses primarily on academics but also incorporates social skills components. <p>Upper School A (Full day)- Our Upper School A class (8:30 am-2:30 pm) is a program that focuses on both academics and vocational. Within this class, students receive academic instruction combined with Vocational (Life Skills). Academics are tailored to each student's current academic ability based on their performance during our intake assessments. This program focuses on Activities for Daily Living, which include cleaning, meal preparation, and community opportunities. <p>Upper School B (Full day)- Our Upper School B class (8:30 am-2:30 pm) is a program that is academically rigorous and requires students to be independent and ready to transition into the community successfully. Unlike our other classes, this class is similar to a general education classroom. This class includes academics that require students to be able to complete tasks and assignments that can be done independently or with minimal help. Accommodations are provided as needed. Tuition FAQ

Does ABELS accept scholarships?

- Yes, ABELS Academy proudly accepts scholarships, including Step-Up for Students and the Florida Tax Credit(FTC).

Does ABELS offer monthly payment plans?

- Yes, ABELS tuition and fees are broken up over the course of the school year (10 months). Tuition is due on the 15th of each month beginning August 15th.

Are the fees annual? What are they for?

- Yes, the fees are annual fees that cover the school year.
 - **Enrollment fee-** this covers the costs of enrollment for new students. The enrollment fee is \$100 for re-enrolling students.
 - **Assessment fee-** this covers the costs of the various assessments that are done to test academic levels to make sure we are presenting academically appropriate material to each of our students.
 - **Curriculum fee-** this covers the costs of the various curriculum we use.

Can my student's scholarship cover the fees?

- If your student's scholarship is equal to or more than the total of the tuition and fees, it can cover the assessment and curriculum fees. However, if your student joins or is withdrawn mid-year, there will be an out-of-pocket cost for the portion of the fees that will not/have not been paid by the scholarship.
