Highway 367 / Highway 319 Traffic Signal

WHEREAS, the City of Ward understands Federal-aid Elimination of Hazards at Railway-Highway Crossings funds will pay for the construction of the railroad crossing improvements and the installation of the traffic signal; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ward will be responsible for the traffic signal upon completion of the construction of the project.

SECTION I: The City will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility in this project, which includes providing electrical service, maintenance of the traffic signal and associated control equipment.


SECTION II: The City pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department to initiate action to implement this project.
