APPOINT RECORDS OFFICER

REPORT ON KEN'S LAKE: Dale reported that the the large amount of water that was disappearing daily from the lake has stopped. No logical reason for the disappearance of this water has been determined at this time but Dale will continue to monitor. The lake is currently losing about 2 1/2 acre feet per day and still could run out by September 5 based on the large amount of water previously lost so we do need to keep pumping from the Corbin, White and Beeman wells.

REPORT ON KEN'S LAKE

BEEMAN WELL: Horace Beeman wants \$180,000 for the water rights. He is investigating the tax implications to selling before providing a dollar amount for the well. Gary suggested that we find a piece of property by the pipeline and drill our own well if the Beeman well does not become an option. Dale noted that there is a trailer located on the old pipeline to the well. Horace will give us the right-ofway to reroute the line around the trailer.
