

Carty Cupboard



On the first Sunday of each month, FCC gathers non-perishable food items for the Carty Cupboard Food Pantry at Wesley United Methodist Church in Worcester. Items are collected in the baskets in the front of the church. They can use just about anything that has a good shelf life. Please **check the expiration dates** before donating. They also feature different items every month which are posted on our bulletin board in the narthex. They can also use personal items such as toothpaste, toothbrushes, shampoo, diapers, etc. If you would like to support the effort with a financial contribution, please make checks payable to Wesley United Methodist Church – Carty Cupboard. The Missions Committee delivers everything to Carty Cupboard.

What does Carty Cupboard do?

Carty Cupboard Food Pantry provides a three-day food supplement for hungry individuals and families who find themselves in need, regardless of age, gender, race, nationality, religious affiliation or personal circumstance. Cupboard visitors are kept confidential in a computer database, and are allowed to pick up food once each month. Mondays 6:00 – 7:00 pm; Wednesdays 1:00 – 3:00 pm and Fridays 10:00 am – noon. It is open to any resident of Worcester County.
