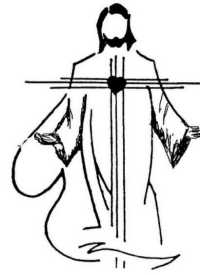

FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY - Saturday June 20

The Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary provides us with a wonderful opportunity to consider the interior life of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We reflect on her joys and sorrows, her virtues and hidden

perfections, and, above all, her virginal love for God the Father; her maternal love for her son Jesus; and her compassionate love for all people. The aim of devotion to Mary's Immaculate Heart is to unite humankind to God through her loving heart, through consecration and reparation and to imitate her love for God and Jesus. We can unite ourselves to Mary for this purpose by imitating her virtues. In recognition of these she graciously gave Catherine Labouré the miraculous medal and personally visited the world at Fatima. Pope Francis announced that he would consecrate the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on October 13, 2013.



MASS DISPENSATION

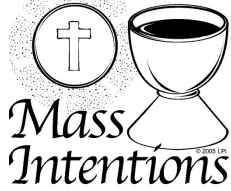
The Archbishop's dispensation from Mass attendance will remain in effect until further direction is provided. The following information provides some other options for you that you might consider.
