1930 - 1993

Virgil "Jim" Wells, 63 of Linwood and formerly of Casnoville, died Friday, Nov. 19 at Bay Medical Center, Bay City, after suffering a ruptured aneurysm.

He was born Feb. 17, 1930 in Grand Blanc Twp. and moved to Huron County as a child with his parents, the late George and Susan (Roberts) Wells. He was united in marriage to Violet Fitchett in Elton on March 3, 1956.
