

Extend your stay in South Africa with a visit to a private safari lodge and camp. The Pilanesberg National Park covers some 55,000ha and is the fourth largest in southern Africa. The park is located on the eroded vestiges of a volcanic crater one of only three such craters in the world. It is here on the undulating hills and open savannahs; sightings of the Big Five: lion, elephant, leopard, Cape buffalo, and rhinoceros, an abundance of wildlife and over 360 bird species can be enjoyed. Close-up and personal encounters can be on bush walks and game drives accompanied by skilled field guides. Be sure to take your camera to capture these once in a lifetime memories.

**DAY 1: NOVEMBER 17, 2022** 

**Travel to The Pilanesberg National Park** 

Bakubung Bush Lodge

From Cape Town, fly to Johannesburg and transfer to Pilanesberg for a safari experience in one of the world's preeminent wildlife sanctuaries. Lunch is on our own this afternoon if not provided in flight.



After lunch, check in and begin your adventure on an **afternoon game drive**. Explore the park and perhaps see some of the free-roaming Big 5 Safari Animals (lion, buffalo, elephant, rhino, and leopard). With one of the lodge's experienced rangers in an open safari vehicle you might see elands and zebras. Keep your eyes open for cheetah and hippo, as well as the tall, graceful giraffe.

### **DAY 2: NOVEMBER 18, 2022**

**Explore the Park** 

Bakubung Bush Lodge

As the animals prefer to feed during the cool temperatures of early morning, you'll venture out early to witness exotic plant and animal life in the gentle light of the dawn. Close examination of the riverbank will likely reveal lazy hippos and steel-jawed crocodiles. Your guide can help you spot some, or all, of the Big Five: lion, Cape buffalo, rhinoceros, leopard, and elephant. Since late 1979, thanks to Operation Genesis - the largest game translocation ever undertaken at the time, tourists have been able to take note of nature's alphabet - from aardyark to zebra.



The park boasts healthy populations of lion, leopard, black and white rhino, elephant and buffalo - Africa's "Big Five". A wide variety of rare and common species exist with endemic species like the nocturnal brown hyaena, the fleet-footed cheetah, the majestic sable, as well as giraffe, zebra, hippo and crocodile, to mention but a few.

After lunch by your own arrangement, continue your game-spotting adventures.

### DAY 3: NOVEMBER 19, 2022 Another Day of Safaris

Bakubung Bush Lodge

Continue with game drives. The enormity of the park does necessitate significant travel time to explore and observe the most interesting wildlife interactions.

You're sure to notice an abundance of colorful bird life throughout the park. Observe how the animals blend into their surroundings, as your guide helps you encounter rare and extraordinary animals ranging from the powerful and agile cheetah to the great baboon. You may also witness the rugged wildebeest, the cagey hyena, and many types of antelope during your adventure.

Lunch will be on your own this afternoon.

Dinner will be provided back at your hotel this evening.

# DAY 4: NOVEMBER 20, 2022 Fly Home

Return to the lodge for breakfast so you have time to pack and check-out for your drive back to Johannesburg. Check in for your international flight home and say farewell to South Africa.

Connect for your domestic flights home after an early morning arrival back in the U.S. today.
