BYLAW NO. 6-2016

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM, TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE DISCHARGE OF SEWAGE INTO THE SEWAGE SYSTEM, TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER, AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF THE SEWAGE SYSTEM.

The Council of the Town of Preeceville, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be cited as "The Water and Sewer Bylaw".
- 2. In this Bylaw,
 - a. "Town means the Town of Preeceville
 - b. "Administrator" means the Administrator of the Town of Preeceville.
- 3. Persons who want to be supplied with water and sewer from the Town's systems must make application to the Administrator.
- 4. Each application shall be accompanied by the payment of a water and sewer deposit in the sum of \$200.00. If water at the desired location has been turned off, there will be a non-refundable charge of \$40.00 to have the water service turned back on.
- 5. The water and sewer deposit shall be refunded upon service being discontinued at the request of the consumer, provided all water and sewage usage charges have been paid in full.
- 6. The Town shall have the right to limit the amount of water furnished to any consumer, should circumstances seem to warrant such action.
- 7. Water meters shall be read four times per year. Hereinafter, each of the dates, on which the water meters shall be read, shall be called the "billing date". The dates, on which the meters shall be read, shall be on, or before, March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31.
- 8. The charges to be paid by the water consumers, whose water service has been connected, shall be those set out in "Schedule A" attached to, and forming part of, this Bylaw.
- 9. The charges to be paid by persons who own, or occupy, premises drained, or that are by bylaw required to be drained, into the sewer are those set out in "Schedule B" attached to, and forming part of, this Bylaw.
- 10. Accounts for water service and/or sewer service shall cover a period of three successive months, and shall be rendered on, or before, seven days into the month next following such period. Accounts shall be paid within thirty days of the billing date. If payment is not received by the end of the thirty days following billing date, water services shall be disconnected.
- 11. No person shall convey, sell, dispose of, or give away water, or permit water to be carried or taken away, or use it or supply it for the use or benefit of others.
- 12. a. No person shall discharge into any drain, sewer, or sewage system, operated by the Town, a harmful matter, substance, or thing, whether liquid or solid, that would be injurious to health, life, or property, or that would injure, pollute, or damage any stream, watercourse, drain, sewer, sewage system, or sewage treatment plant.



- b. The service of any person who contravenes this section of this Bylaw shall be discontinued.
- 13. If the water supply is disconnected from the premises of a consumer, for infringement of the provision of this Bylaw, it shall not be reconnected until all arrears, penalties, rates, charges, \$40 reconnection fee and deposit in the amount of \$200.00 have been paid in full. If this is a first offence, the service will be disconnected for a minimum period of twenty-four (24) hours and if this is a second or more offence, the service will be disconnected for a minimum period of fortyeight (48) hours.
- If any charges are unpaid one month after billing, interest at the rate of 1 1/2% per 14. month will be added to the unpaid balance.
- If any rates or charges in arrears remain unpaid on December 31, that amount may 15. be added to, and thereby form part of, the taxes on the land or buildings with respect to which the service was provided.
- Any person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw, for which no other 16. penalty is provided, shall be guilty of an offense and liable, upon summary conviction, to penalties provided for under the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town.
- Bylaw No. 2-2007 and Bylaw No. 5-2005 are hereby repealed. 17.
- This bylaw shall come into force, and take effect, on the 1st day of October, 2016 18. pending approval being issued by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.
