## Women's Fry Pan Toss 2021– OFFICAL RULES

- Open to all the world's women ages 18+
- The object of the competition is to throw a cast iron fry pan the longest and closest to the center line. The distance is where the fry pan first lands, the distance off the center line is subtracted
- Registration will be held on Sunday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2021 at 2:30 p.m. inside the fairgrounds, through Gate C near the Truck & Tractor Pulling Area on the corner of Deerfield Avenue and 1875 Way.
- The first 50 women who register in person will need to be in the competition area (Truck and Tractor Pulling Area) at 3:45 p.m. to check-in and prepare for the competition.
- The 144<sup>th</sup> Deerfield Fair Woman's Fry Pan Toss will start promptly @ 4 p.m. on Sunday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2021 in the Truck and Tractor Pulling Area.
- An official competition cast iron fry pan will be provided by the fair.
- One underhand throw only (no practice tosses), running and walking tosses are permitted.
- Any woman who touches or crosses the start line during their throw, a whistle will sound immediately by the judges and said woman will be disqualified.
- Toss will be straight out the course and wherever the fry pan first touches the ground will be considered the official mark. The distance off the center line will be subtracted from the distance tossed.
- The top 10 women with the longest distance will be ribboned ( $1^{st}$  place  $10^{th}$  place)
- The top 3 women from Toss#1 (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places) will go on to complete in the "TOSS OFF aka/Toss #2". The woman who has the longest combined tosses (Toss off #1 + Toss off #2=\_\_\_) will be the Grand Champion and win \$250 prize.
