





OLD BUSINESS

1. Prayer Tent (OUTREACH/EVANGELISM) -

Replies received: Michael reported that we have received replies from the following individuals/churches: Grenada Berean, LenaTallerico and Carol Crebbin, Yreka Nazarene and Mt. Zion Lutheran.
