

Supply list—Woodland Santa

No sewing machine needed as long as they get their pre-sewing finished

BSK - with hand embroidery needle and sharp scissors that will have to cut through paper

Fabric: needs to be 100% cotton

Sky background piece – 11 ½” x 8”

Snow background piece – 11 ½” x 5”

Plaid fabric for Santa’s shirt, cap and borders – cut borders as follows:

2 – 12 ½” x 1 ½”

2 – 13 ½” x 1 ½”

1 – 8” x 5” for shirt and hat

Fabric for pants and mitten – something that compliments the plaid

3 greens for tree (1 light, 1 medium, 1 dark)

Black for boots and suspenders

Brown for tree trunk and bear (can be the same or different)

White for beard

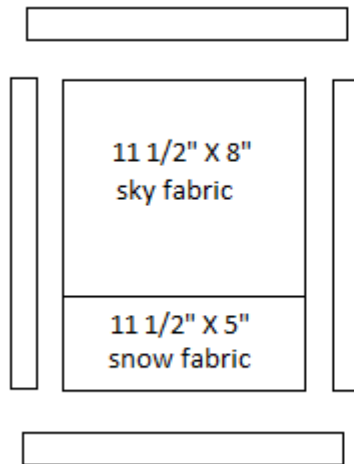
Gray or gold for star

Flesh color for face

Embroidery floss:

1 skein black

Little bit of white



**Pre-sewing instructions:**

Using a 1/4" seam allowance stitch the sky fabric to the snow fabric as shown. Then stitch the 12 1/2" plaid border strips to the sides. And last, sew the 13 1/2" border strips to the top and bottom.

If you get this finished before class then you do not need to bring a sewing machine to class. If you are unable to get it sewn then bring a sewing machine and rotary cutting equipment.

You can also bring a piece of fabric for a backing and batting – both measuring 17” X 18” and some basting thread. If you get the hand stitching finished in class then we can prepare it for quilting.
