McDougald stated he felt that this was already committed to those customers. Dale asked the Board if we should sell water in San Juan County without annexation. Georgia stated she felt this additional sale would not place the District in more jeopardy than it already is. Georgia asked if when we annex these customers, could we word the annexation to read to include all Grand County except other Water Districts, to take care of any possible changes in Dutch moved the District proceed with annexation of County Boundaries. San Juan Co. customers, and the District bear the cost of annexation. George asked Stan if the State lands could be included. George suggested the owners of deeded land be contacted to see if they want to be included in the annexation. Georgia seconded. MOTION CARRIED. George suggested a meeting be held at the Courthouse with all the customers regarding annexation, and Dan suggested they be contacted so they can bring the legal description of the land they wanted to annex, so the petition can be signed at that meeting.
