Description of the Job:

Under supervision of the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent. Responsible for performing all mechanical and electrical maintenance and repairs of equipment at wastewater collection systems.

Essential Functions to be Performed:

- Inspects pumps, valves, and other equipment in wastewater collections system;
- Makes mechanical and electrical adjustments to equipment;

Essential Functions to be Performed: (continued)

- Performs maintenance duties on all wastewater collection equipment;
- Lubricates pumps and motors, adjusts belts, repairs equipment;
- Replaces inoperable equipment when necessary; operates hydraulic jet machine to clear plugged sewers and the sludge truck to remove sludge;
- Takes and interprets readings of temperatures, pressure, weights, flow, and other data which are obtained from various gauges and meters;
- Operates and inspects various equipment and vehicles such as jet/vac, jet truck, tanker truck, tows, pumps and generators with pick-ups, service trucks, etc;
- Assists in small purchases and receiving, storing and issuing of supplies, tools and equipment;
- Works irregular or expanded hours in case of emergencies;
- Notifies Superintendent when additional supplies, equipment, or repairs are needed.

Other Functions to be Performed:

- Collects samples of wastewater;
- Maintains inventory of supplies and picks up supplies;
- Maintains structures and grounds; Shovels snow, cuts grass, and performs general cleaning and maintenance tasks by using appropriate hand and power tools;
- Assists in maintaining inventory of equipment, supplies and vehicles;
- Communicates information to general public, personnel, contractors, suppliers, etc., responding to inquiries and complaints;
- Assist in an explanation of policies and procedures;
- Maintains, records, compiles data and prepares reports as required;
- Attends meetings and seminars;
- Performs other related duties as required.




Physical Requirements:
