PLEASE READ FULLY! Please mail/email back the signed liability information form and the filled-out child permission slip if it applies to your party.

IMPORTANT NOTE!! All minors (members under the age 18) must have a completed and signed permission slip (including medical information) from their parent/legal guardian, even if the parent/guardian will be attending the event with the child(ren). Additionally, the responsible party or parties must be present with the minor for the duration of the event. Children will not be able to board a shuttle vehicle and participate in activities without an accompanying parent/relative and signed forms.

Summit Lake Paiute Tribe acknowledges there is risk involved with the event remoteness and activities and will endeavor to make the event safe to a reasonable level. Therefore, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe will not be liable for any injuries or death that may occur during this event. In addition, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe won't be liable for any property that you bring up being stolen, lost, or broken. It is recommended that any vehicles being brought up be all-terrain vehicles because of the conditions of the dirt roads. It is also recommended to have at least one spare all-terrain tire (maybe two if your vehicle doesn't have all-terrain tires) with you when driving up. Gas will not be for sale on the reservation but will be available in Gerlach or Winnemucca. Due to the risk of invasive species introduction, no personal boats or watercraft are allowed to be brought up. Wi-Fi is available at the reservation but will only be available in case of emergencies, no additional cell coverage is available at the reservation. For the safety of your pets, please leave them at home for the weekend.

- Sleeping bag, sleeping pad, extra blankets, pillows
- Tent(s) (if able to bring your own) If you requested housing be aware that tents will be group housing and you will not be receiving individual tents for your party!
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Warm pajamas (night temperatures can get VERY cold so be prepared)
- Close-toed shoes/ layered outdoor clothing (we recommend bringing clothing that is comfortable to move around in and you don't mind getting dirty. NO FLIP FLOPS OR SANDALS!)
- Raingear
- Sunscreen and tick/insect repellent. This year, ticks are at an all-time high!
- Stories and/or games
- Flashlights/ lamps/headlamps (may want to bring extra batteries)
- Portable charger for electronics

- Medication (any prescribed medications, ibuprofen, aspirin, Dramamine)

- Fishing gear (if planning to fish); nets, waders, coolers/ice for transportation, and poles
