

These F1 baldy heifers are AI'd to Tehama Tahoe and were then cleaned up with Tahoe sons purchased from Talkington Angus. Tahoe is known for being a complete bull with calving ease, growth and carcass quality in a moderate, wide-bodied package. These heifers are out of Reich Angus cows and are sired by 5 ET full brothers by the Hereford bull Churchill Ram.

These heifers will weigh 1,150 lbs. and were ultrasounded for sex and calving date by Dr. Travis Kuhlka of TK Veterinary Service. They are on a full herd health and mineral program. They've been vaccinated with CattleMaster 5 VL5 and poured with Dectomax.

These heifers will weigh 1,100 lbs. and were ultrasounded by Dr. Kristi Pennington. They have been on a full health and mineral program, including Vira Shield 6VL5 and poured with Dectomax. They have also received Scour Boss 9.



We purchased a very nice set of heifers from Perry and Sandy last spring. Ecker's cattle need no introduction in McKenzie county. This is a true reputation herd. The Eckers have maintained a very disciplined breeding program for over 40 years. The base of their genetics came from EXT and Shoshone Angus sires that they bred to artificially in the 1980's. They have continued to use Shoshone and Sinclair genetics along with bulls from Best Angus. Perry and Sandy have a beautiful set of cows that run in really tough badlands pastures right next to ours. Even though these heifers ran in some of the most rugged badlands you will find, 93% conceived in a 45 day breeding season. Fertility, longevity and intelligence are bred into these females.

The heifers were synchronized and Aled to Best Box Cross 291. Box Cross is a sleep all night heifer bull that sires excellent females and feeder calves that really grow. They were cleaned up with calving ease bulls raised by us. They were ultrasounded by JJ Hovde from High Plains Vet. Clinic. They have been given ViraShield and will be poured prior to sale time. These moderate framed heifers will weigh about 1100 pounds at sale time.

These heifers will weigh 1,100 pounds and were ultrasounded by Mandan Vet Clinic for sex and date, are gentle and cake broke. They have received a full health and mineral program, including Vira Shield 6 VL5 HB, drenched with Safe Guard and poured with Saber at ultrasound time. These heifers are moderate in their frame, deep and wide bodied, easyfleshing females. They are the type and kind to set an operation up for future profit and success!


