Dear Surviving Spouse:

The Delta Pilots Disability and Survivorship Plan ("Plan") was recently amended. Effective July 1, 2012, the Plan provides that the Spouse (as defined by the Plan) of a former pilot who died from active service or disability prior to September 1, 2001 (a "pre-September 2001 surviving spouse") will remain eligible for survivor income benefits from the Plan, if the surviving Spouse remarries.

The purpose of this letter is to notify you of this change to the Plan. As an eligible surviving spouse, if you are to remarry after 7/1/12, then you will remain eligible for survivor income benefits from the Plan. Also, as a reminder, in order for a pre-September 2001 surviving spouse to remain eligible for survivor income benefits from the Plan, all other eligibility requirements of the Plan must continue to be met.
