and "Agape" in such a special way had that same feeling.



In John Ortberg's book, *Everybody's Normal Til You Get To Know Them*, he writes "It takes people to make people sick and it takes people to make people well." Theologically this is not entirely true. But there is some truth to what he says. I am always shocked and distressed at how great we are at breaking other human beings. In fact there are times when we seem to delight at breaking other human beings. It is no secret that we live in a hurting and broken world that clearly needs fixing.

Emmaus is great way to have a hand in "fixing" the world When I think back to my own Emmaus walk the word that clearly stands out is healing. Above everything else, healing is what occurred during my Emmaus experience. Of course there are varying degrees of brokenness in the world and obviously there are some folks who need healing more than others. But healing is without a doubt paramount in the Emmaus experience.

The wonderful news for those of us who have been on a walk to Emmaus is that God gives us the opportunity to have a part in the healing experience. Ortberg writes, "for better or for worse we are shaped more by people than by any other force in life. In the same way, more than anything else, God uses people to heal people." God calls us and uses us as facilitators of healing during the course of a weekend. What a wonderful opportunity for us! Each time I work on a walk I arreminded of God's power and presence to take even the worst of situations and literally make them into something good. What an incredible display of the power of God at work!

As you make yourselves available to serve on upcoming walks remember that you are being given the opportunity to bring about healing in a person's life and consequently, in a small way, have a hand in changing the world! What a wonderful opportunity we are given when we serve; don't ever short change the opportunity you are given.


