OUR PARISH STEWARDSHIP OF TREASURE CAMPAIGN NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT

To date \$177,433.00 has been received in stewardship pledges towards our Parish Stewardship of Treasure Campaign. This represents 39% participation for the

FATHER PETER UPDATE

Father Peter Adoko-Enchill has been in the Archdiocese for five years, most recently serving as priest administrator of St. Mary Star of the Sea Catholic Church in Port Townsend. He was here in the U.S. on an R-1 VISA, which is a non-immigrant visa for religious

workers. These VISAs last for 5 years, after which the employer must apply for permanent residency on the person's behalf or the visa-holder must leave the country.

The Archdiocese of Seattle began the application process for a new permanent resident visa for Fr. Peter earlier this year. Unfortunately, the Immigration Service can be slow and unpredictable. As of this week, Immigration has not yet processed Fr. Peter's initial paperwork. The Archdiocese is able to track the case status. Officially, his paperwork is still in process.

Because Fr. Peter's authorized stay has expired, he will wait in Ghana for U.S. immigration authorities to process the initial paperwork. After which, he will need to complete the permanent residency process through Homeland Security and the U.S. Consulate in Ghana. The timing for this process is unknown at this time.

We ask that you continue to pray for Fr. Peter and for the thousands of other people in his same situation. We also ask that you pray for the immigration authorities so that they may provide a speedy resolution for families waiting for news about their future status.


