



Captain Thomas E. Jones USNR (Ret) June 22, 1931 - August 21, 2018

S/M Jones was a FRA Member of 32 years. He served aboard the USS Wisconsin and the USS Intrepid, as well as at the US Merchant Marine Academy. He left active duty because he felt his dream naval career was incompatible with family life, but he continued to drill in the Reserves, serving at the Naval Reserve Surface Division 3-76(L)

and 3-77(L), Group Command 5-5(M) and the Naval Reserve Readiness Command. In the Reserves, he commanded the Naval Reserve Surface Division 5-37(L) and was the Naval Reserve Director of Naval Education and Training HQ Unit 106, with the latter resulting in him earning the Navy Commendation Medal and the Unit earning the Navy Unit Commendation. He also received a commendation letter for leadership from the Secretary of the Navy.
