
Day Four

^(1:14-15) The Source of Life said, "<u>Let there</u> <u>be Lamps in the solid plate of the Skies to</u> <u>distinguish between the Day and between</u> <u>the Night; and let them be for appointed</u> <u>times, and for days, and for years; and let</u> <u>them be for Lamps in the solid plate of the</u> <u>Skies, to cause Light to be over the</u> <u>Earth</u>." And it was so.

^(1:16-19) *The Source of Life* <u>made</u> two great Lamps; <u>the greater Lamp</u> to rule the Day and <u>the lesser Lamp</u> to rule the Night -and <u>the Stars</u>. *The Source of Life* <u>set</u> <u>them in the solid plate</u> of the Skies, to cause Light to be over the Earth, to rule in



the Day and in the Night, and to distinguish between the Light and between the Darkness. *The Source of Life* **saw** that **the Greater Lamp, the Lesser Lamp, and the Stars are good for Life**. And it was evening, and it was morning, **Day Four**.
