
Membership Dues

Our Lodge has been inducted into the **Wilmington High School Athletic Hall of Fame**, and we received this plaque which hangs in the High School hall. It reads – The Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli Lodge #2183, has been one of the most generous organizations in the Town of Wilmington. They have financially supported the schools and the community in general. The Lodge has supported youth sports, installed new playgrounds and equipment at the North Intermediate and Woburn Street Schools, provided stadium jackets for the Marching Band and uniforms for the Color Guard. They have provided thousands of dollars in scholarships. They have provided scoreboards for Alumni Stadium, the Dick Scanlon Baseball Field, and the Woburn Street School; indoor batting cages for the baseball and softball teams; purchased uniforms for various Wildcat Sports Teams; and sponsored the WHS Holiday Wrestling Tournament for over twenty-five years.
