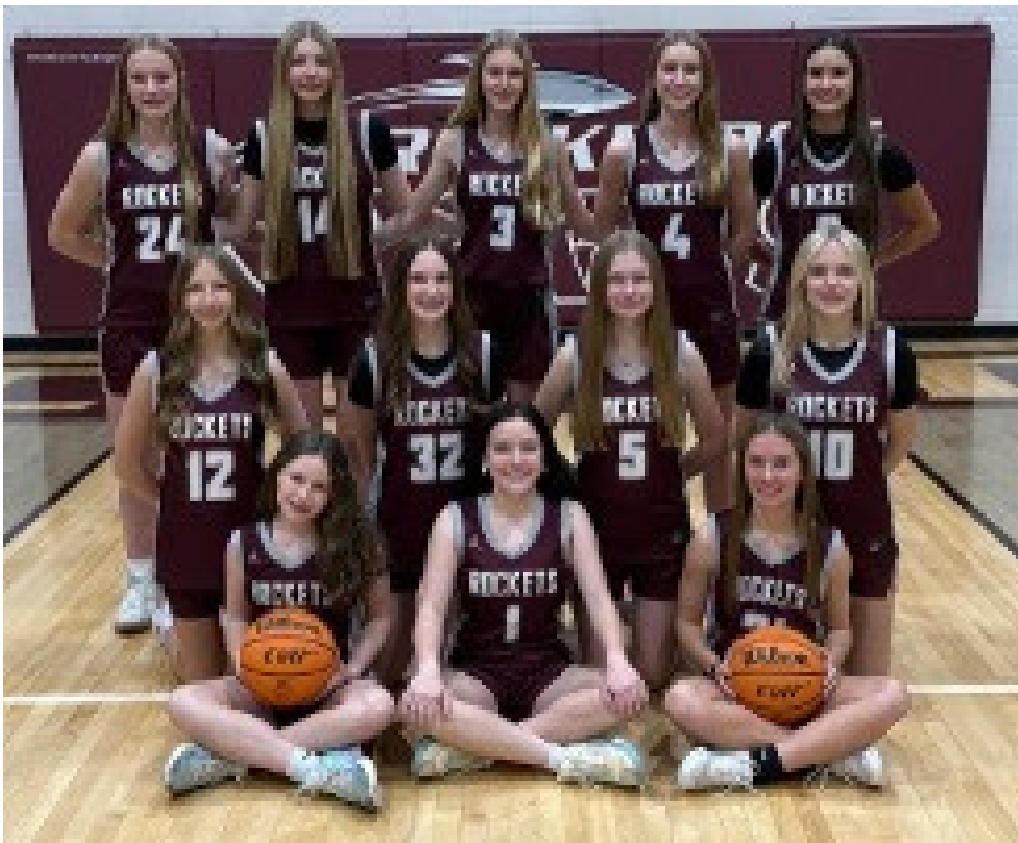

For nearly two decades, Elliott has given selflessly of his time as a volunteer coach and mentor, using athletics as a platform to instill discipline, character, and hope in young people throughout the Quad Cities.**

**Guided by faith and a deep commitment to service, Elliott's influence extends far beyond the court. His leadership reflects a calling to uplift others, empower youth, and strengthen community through example and encouragement. Elliott embodies the spirit of the Pillar of Light award—shining consistently as a source of guidance, integrity, and inspiration for the next generation.**



**Seneca Gray first began coaching as an assistant for the QC Patriots in 2016. He was assistant for 3 years when that group went on to high school. He saw the need for more positive role models and realized he could provide it through something he enjoyed. So, he continued coaching various teams out of Beyond The Baseline. Seneca used coaching as a tool to help build relationships with the kids and show them that through "Attitude, Effort, and Energy" they could accomplish anything they put their minds to. It gave him great pleasure to watch the kids grow more confident in themselves on and off the court. One of his favorite sayings was, "We're either all in or we're all out." From 2016 until his untimely departure on earth in May 2025 Seneca D. Gray was "All In".**



**From 2010–2013, Marcus, alongside his EZ Work Elite partner Terry Evans, partnered with the great Terry Brooks Sr to help bring back the Rock town 340s youth program. During this time, they oversaw and supported seven youth teams, providing structure, mentorship, and competitive opportunities for young athletes throughout the community. Sports began as a hobby and a way to bond with his children, but ultimately became a lifestyle. Through coaching, Marcus formed an unbreakable bond with his kids—especially his two oldest, whom he coached for over eight years. Teammates became family, friendships became lifelong connections, and the lessons extended far beyond the game.**

**Marcus believes that being relatable is one of the most important things today's youth needs. He feels a responsibility to give back and be present for kids coming from where he comes from—and beyond—showing them what's possible through consistency, care, and commitment.**
