DESCRIPTION: This was Indian's higher-end short hunting bow. Great looking and performing reconditioned short hunting bow. African Rosewood riser with phenolic riser center. Black overlays on both the face and back of the riser. Black tip overlays. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in good condition. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few filled screw holes on the side of the riser and back (see pics on pages 6 & 7). A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in fair shape. Overall, this is a nice bow for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed); then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new rug rest and strike plate, and a new string.

This bow sold for \$75 in 1969, which translates to \$675 in 2025 inflation adjusted dollars.
