Prayers of the People



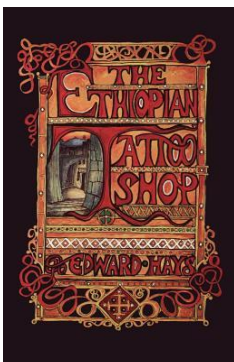
We pray:
