School is just about out for the summer, which means more activity on the streets and in the parks.

Please keep in mind the following items:

- **All town parks and restrooms are closed at 9pm**
- Bicycles are to be kept off the sidewalks and need to follow the same traffic laws that apply to motorists
- Any group activity in the town parks require a permit (available at Town Hall) and \$10 fee
- Youth baseball games will be utilizing the ball parks Mondays-Thursdays through June.
- It is unlawful to not clean up after your pet on any street, sidewalk or publicly owned park. Bag it and place it in the trash.
- The compost facility located behind Town Hall is available to all SE Spokane County residents, for a nominal fee, and is open during regular business hours. The facility accepts clean, green materials suitable for composting.

FIREWORKS

ORDINANCE NO. 16-02

All fireworks are prohibited except certain "common fireworks" also known as "safe and sane" fireworks.

Common fireworks are only allowed from noon on July 3rd until midnight on July 4th.
