



July is our semi annual Swap Meet!!!

Fishing action is going off all over the southland. Saltwater is being spotlighted with a white seabass and bluefin tuna bite. Freshwater lakes are at their highest point in years. It appears to be an outstanding year.

Free fishing date in California is July 6, 2019, but remember you can fish off piers without a license. Just be aware of the species restrictions. Lee Lake aka Whittier Narrows is hosting it's annual campout and catfish derby on Friday July 12, 2019. Laura Jones, a club member is heading up this event. Registration begins at 3pm until 10 pm. You can camp and fish all night but if you leave the parking lot after 10pm you cannot drive back in. Catfish will be stocked and there will be a raffle drawing for fishing gear and other prizes. They usually have free food and in the past food trucks have been know to stop by. Bait will be available for free.

Santa Fe Dam is presenting Moonlight Fishing on July 26, August 30, and September 27, 2019. Registration is from 6pm till 10pm and fees of \$10.00 for kids and adults 16 or older and \$10.00 for parking will be charged. The July Fury trip is our big Saltwater event this month. The boat is out of Dana Wharf and leaves at 10pm. returning approximately 7pm the next day. Fresh Water Event Update

There are no fresh outings planned during the summer.

These trips are open to all club members and your guests. There is no cost involved other than beach parking and entry into the lakes.

Only game fish are eligible for the five fish jack pot entry. The total weight of up to five fish will be your entry. Surf fish only Corbina, Perch and Halibut. No Sharks or Rays. Fresh water Trout, Small Mouth Bass, Large Mouth Bass, Stripers and Cat Fish. No Carp or Gold Fish. You can use either natural or artificial baits.

Start any time after the lakes open or 7:00 am for surf fishing. We usually fish the lakes until 2:00 pm and surf fish until noon or until high tide.

If you are interested in going on these outings and have never been before, let me know and if there is enough interest, we can have a Saturday morning get together to discuss tackle and techniques.

Remember, everyone is welcome to participate. That means bring your kids, grand kids, great grand kids, friends and neighbors.

All of the lakes have boat launching, boat rentals, shore fishing as well as float tube and kayak access. One last note, if you are a boater bring a non-boater member with you.


