
## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

## IT WAS DESTINEE!



Saint Peter's Male Choir Anniversary will be held on Saturday, April 8, 2017 at 6:00 PM. A donation of \$25.00 is requested.


The Easter Egg Hunt will be Saturday, April 8th. Time: 12:00 Noon.




#### A VALENTINE'S GALA FOR WATEREE DISTRICT


