

## Shade Trees

### Chitalpa (Pink Dawn)

Chitalpa is an intergeneric cross between *Catalpa bignonioides* and *Chilopsis linearis*. It is an unusual small flowering accent tree, especially useful in riparian or native garden settings, usually multi-trunked or low-branching. It blooms best in full sun, when it receives moderate moisture. It becomes taller in half shade. Its grayish-white bark presents an interesting silhouette in winter with its bare branches. It generally remains below 25' in height.

## **Jacquemontri Birch**

Foliage: Dark green, leathery leaves, oval shape with golden yellow fall colour. Bark: White bark that peels. Height: 25 to 60 feet. Spread: 15 feet. Shape: Upright, narrow oval and single-trunked with low branches  
Growth Characteristics: Fast-growing. The Jacquemonti Birch has the whitest bark of all the birch varieties, starting even when the tree is very young. The striking white trunk makes a beautiful contrast against darker foliage.

## **Krauter Flowering Plum**

The Krauter Vesuvius Purple Leaf Plum is a small tree, reaching 15 to 20 feet tall and spreading about the same distance wide. It has a dense, upright crown of many branches, and in spring they are covered in a profuse blooming of small pale-pink flowers.

## **Raywood Ash**

Raywood Ash, botanical name *Fraxinus oxycarpa* 'Raywood,' is a Mediterranean native that can grow to be a large tree with a round-headed form, so it is capable of providing the right amount of summer shade! It's a favorite in landscapes throughout the Southwest both for its shade coverage as well as the beautiful fall color it brings to yards! In the fall, the attractive dark green leaves turn to an alluring red wine color. Once the leaves fall, it can let the warmth of the sun in, and you'll only need to do a one-time easy cleanup! The foliage comes back in the spring, just in time to cool off your home and keep you comfortable while you're enjoying your yard! Grows up to 60-70'.

## **Red Maple**

Brings color to your landscape year-round. Green stems turn red in winter, new leaves are red-tinged, turning to green. Fall color is deep red or yellow. Flowers are also red. Fast growing and tolerant of many soils. Grows to 40' to 60', 40' spread. (zones 3-9). Grows to a height of 40-60'. Growth Rate – 13" – 24" / year.

## **Silver Maple**

Very fast-growing. Leaves are green on top and silvery-white on the underside, shimmering and dancing in the breeze. Tolerates a wide range of soil conditions. Because of a vigorous root system, plant 10' or more from sidewalks, drives, foundations, and sewer lines. Grows to 50' to 80' with spread 2/3 of height to wider than the tree is tall. (zones 3-9)

## **Sycamore**

Sycamore trees are huge deciduous trees with a broad, rounded crown of lush green foliage. Sycamore trees have serrated lobed leaves that resemble maple leaves with three to five lobes. Sycamores have thin, peeling reddish-brown bark and seed balls that drop in spring. Sycamore trees grow to between 100 and 130 ft. (30 – 40 m) tall.

## **Weeping Flowering Cherry**

The bright pink blossoms bloom double, meaning 2 flowers appear for every bud on the tree. This cherry blossom tree is ideal for landscapes desiring multi-seasonal beauty, as the leaves turn bright yellow in autumn and the weeping limbs draw much interest in the summertime. The Double Pink Weeping Cherry is 1 of the worlds favorite blossom trees, beautifully complementing any landscape.
