Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. Gravel has been spread in front and around the east and west sides of the labyrinth. Trees (6) have been planted. As donations are received, more trees will be placed. We have also planted shrubs and flower bushes and surrounded the area with gravel. Adobe dedication plaques are now in place in the labyrinth courtyard and placement of plaques continue. Once all these are in place, merchants who have supported our project, will also be acknowledged. Each outlying mission will have its own mission statue displayed when funds are available. Please support the volunteers seeking contributions from your placita. Your continued patience & cooperation is greatly appreciated as we work with volunteers in this phase of our project. St. Augustine & Holy Family statues are now in place at the Santuario. In addition, statues of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego will be placed at the entrance and donations are being accepted to begin this phase. Placement of new trees will also be available to contributors interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos. 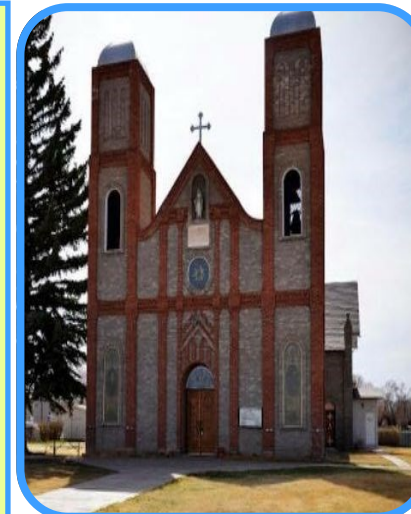

**Theme: Word and Sacrament.**

It can happen that communication through a symbolic action (burning an effigy, giving a present, honoring the flag) is more efficient than simple word communication. Actually, we need both words and signs to communicate with one another. In today's Gospel the disciples respond both to God's word: "Were not our hearts burning within us while he ... opened the Scriptures to us?" and to God's sign (sacrament): "He was made known to them in the breaking of bread." Our growth in faith is made through the ministry of God's word (first part of Mass: Bible readings and explanation in the homily) and comes to its fulfillment in the celebration of the Eucharist—a sacramental (signifying) meal. A Christian can know a great deal about our Lord without knowing him as a person! Make every Sunday worship service a personal encounter with the Lord Jesus in both Scripture and Sacrament (the Eucharist)

**FIRST READING Acts 2:14, 22-33**

**[Reform Your Lives]**

This passage is the first of six major sermons in Acts. All of these six sermons deal with the substance of the Christian message. It is: By dying, Christ destroyed our death and by rising, he restored our life. We look for him to come in glory. Peter's citation from Psalm 16 illustrates the freedom with which the early Church made use of the Hebrew Bible. The Psalm describes God as saving his chosen ones from destruction. Peter applies this to God's chosen one par excellence, Jesus Christ, and brings out his point: God raised up Jesus from the dead according to his "set plan and Foreknowledge"

**SECOND READING 1 Pt 1:17-21**

**[Conduct Yourselves Reverently]**

The writer describes Christ's death and its salutary effect on us in terms of the Jewish Passover: sojourn in a strange land and deliverance by the blood of a spotless Passover lamb. We are still in a strange land, but we are delivered by Christ our Passover Sacrifice. For final deliverance from pain and evil, we have "faith and hope... in God."
