



Bearberry or Kinnikinnick

Arctostaphylos uva ursi



- Size: 2-8”
- Culture: Prefers Sun to shade and dry to moist, well drained acidic soils
- Flower and Fruit: Pink/White flowers in early Spring and red fruits persisting into winter
- Uses: Evergreen ground cover, border, rock garden, poor soils, butterflies, hummingbirds, birds, high wildlife value, host plant for 17 species of butterflies and moths, edible, medicinal, tobacco, dye, salt, wind and deer tolerant
