DESCRIPTION: Here is a Bob Lee (Wing) Colt Plainsman. Wing had the initial contract to produce Colt branded bows as Colt did not produce any of their own bows. Colt bows with Hartford CT in the logo were made by Wing. This bow shows its age and has some wear and tear. However, the bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. There is one significant scratch in the upper face limb (see pic on the last page). This is not a stress line, but was either a deep scratch or a splinter of missing fiberglass (looks more like a deep scratch to me). A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The finish is OK but not great. Decals are in fair-poor condition. Overall, this is a serviceable bow that is certainly no show piece, but a good choice to take in the woods.
