The TBLA Board Election- The annual election of the Board of Directors was completed at last month's membership social. Gary Moore and Mike Scheurich were re-elected to the board for second terms. Toledo Bend Lunker Bass Program – We currently have 12 Lunkers in the 2017-2018 Lunker Bass Program. I am asked frequently, "How are our Lunker numbers so far this year?" Dinah Medine reviewed the records last month and provided the following information. We had a record number of 33 lunkers already registered in the 2015-2016 Lunker Program by mid-October which ultimately had a record high 133 lunkers for the total May to May Program Year. Our second best class was the 2014-2015 Lunker Program year which had 81 total Lunkers and had 11 Lunkers registered by mid-October of 2014, the same as this year. We had 13 Lunkers by mid-October in 2013, 2012, and 2007, and the year totals for those years were 61, 58, and 52 respectively. So we are in the midst of what I would call a typical good year. It will be May of 2018 before we really know how well the Lake is producing these great fish. We thank all of the volunteers and anglers that make the Lunker Program possible.

<u>Toledo Bend Reservoir</u> – Daily Lake levels may be found at: <u>http://www.srala-toledo.com/</u>. The Lake level is currently approximately 167.9 ft. msl. and both generators are shutdown. I have heard a number of folks comment about the low lake level, but did you know that the normal, average lake level for October and November, experienced over the history of the lake is actually 167.122' and 167.512'. It may not seem that way to many of us, but remember we have basically had a "full lake for most of the last 3 years, and as they say, "how soon we forget!"

<u>Safety Awareness for the Lake</u> – Stumps are showing more and more and many are just under the lake's surface. I touched a stump right in the middle of the Lanan Boat Road last week with my prop. Luckily it did not do any damage. Please wear your life jackets and use your kill switches as we see the danger from underwater obstructions grow with the falling lake level.
