About the Directory

The Directory of Community Health, Mental Health and Learning Disabilities 2019/20

The Directory of Community Health, Mental Health and Learning Disabilities reflects the merger of two well established directories — the Directory of Community Health Services and the Directory of Mental Health Services and Learning Disabilities — into one directory with the obvious benefits that this brings. It includes comprehensive information on community nursing, mental health and learning disability services throughout the UK, and reflects the changes in the structure of the NHS and social care services in England now that the PCTs have been abolished.

Independent healthcare providers continue to take on an ever increasing range of services particularly within domiciliary care, mental health and learning disabilities, making this *Directory* an indispensable tool for healthcare professionals of many disciplines, and an extremely important marketing tool for the suppliers of relevant healthcare services.

The *Directory* format continues to reflect the geographical divisions previously described as Strategic Health Authorities, now renamed as NHS Commissioning Boards. Within these we incorporate the Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG's) and Health and Wellbeing Boards (H & WBB's) together with providers, locations and services. This information together with the geographical information has been updated, cross-referenced and indexed to present an overview of how the new structure and services are interrelated.

The Directory listings are organised into sections to make life easier for the user:

1. Governance & Regulatory Organisations

This section includes contact details for the Health and Wellbeing Boards, Clinical Commissioning Groups by region and Local Area Teams, as well as a number of other organisations.

2. Health Listings

Throughout the *Directory* staff members are listed by department within the Trust/Service that employs them. Where a service is shared between Trusts, we have to rely on this information being provided by the Trusts concerned. There are a number of useful alphabetical indexes at the back of the Directory which allow you to search by the name of the health authority or the geographical location.

Entries provide information on community nursing and midwifery and include contact details for central community nursing offices and the following services and personnel:

- Child protection/safeguarding
- · Community matrons
- Community nursing services
- Equipment loan services
- · Health visiting
- School nursing

- · Child health records
- Community midwifery
- District nursing
- Family planning
- Liaison services
- Services for asylum seekers and travellers

The names of senior managers for these services are given, together with addresses and telephone numbers and, where appropriate, emergency/night/twilight numbers. Entries also provide names and contact numbers for clinical nurse specialists, liaison staff and the administration bases for child health records. The Acute and Mental Health Trust entries also include the names and specialities of clinical nurse specialists and practitioners for a wide range of specialities.

NHS England

The information for the NHS in England is organised on a geographical basis, i.e. into the four commissioning regions - NHS London, NHS Midlands and the East, NHS North of England and NHS South of England. Where the Health and Wellbeing Board/Clinical Commissioning Group name is used, it is followed by that of the main provider together with their address and contact details. Services are then listed by department and job role.

NHS Wales

In Wales, seven Health Boards are responsible for providing all health and social care services for their catchment area and the section for Wales is formatted alphabetically by these Boards. The Health Boards are as follows: Swansea Bay University HB, Aneurin Bevan HB, Betsi Cadwaladr University HB, Cardiff and Vale University HB, Cwm Taf HB, Hywel Dda HB and Powys Teaching HB.

NHS Scotland

Health Boards remain responsible for health services throughout Scotland with these services being provided through their Acute and Primary Care Divisions. Each Primary Care Division supports a number of Health & Social Care Partnerships where services are provided jointly by the health board and the local authority. These organisations are included alphabetically within each Health Board.

Health - Northern Ireland

Northern Ireland has a similar structure to Wales with five Health and Social Care Trusts being responsible for all the health and social care needs of their populations.

Health - Offshore

We have included the Channel Islands in the *Directory* even though the financial reciprocal health arrangements have now been terminated. The immediate consequence of this is that any UK resident going on holiday to the Channel Islands now needs to consider taking out health insurance as they will not be covered by the NHS as in the past.

Secondary Care

To ensure that the *Directory* is as complete and accurate as possible and reflects the inter-dependence of the services, we include relevant services provided by the Acute NHS Trusts even though these may not fall within the strict definition of community nursing, learning disability and mental health services. However with the absorption of community services by a number of acute hospitals this is becoming even more important and in many areas a pattern is beginning to emerge whereby all services will be provided through the 'local' acute hospital.

3. Partner Organisations

This section includes contact details for independent healthcare providers together with the services they provide, the Independent Mental Capacity Advocacy Service (IMCA), police forces, as well as a number of other organisations.

4. Social Services

This section covers all UK local authority social care services listed by service with full contact details for each.


