

Covid-19 Safety Precautions

- Pre appointments will be done virtually, by either phone call or video call, to discuss your wedding day, your dress visions and ideas and to gather a list of dresses for trying on.
- On arrival to the boutique the bride and her guest will be shown a statement “I am not exhibiting any Covid-19 symptoms, ie fever or cough” “I have not been in contact with anyone who has symptoms or has the virus in the last 7 days”, and asked to agree or notify staff otherwise.
- One guest to accompany the bride at the fitting so that we can ensure social distancing.
- Unfortunately, we cannot allow under 16’s to visit the boutique until further notice.
- Video calls ie Facetime will be encouraged so the rest of your squad can join the fun.
- Boutique staff, the bride and her guest will be required to wear masks and gloves. The masks may be removed when social distancing is possible.
- All dresses are to be taken off the rails and handled by staff only.
- The bride will be shown how to put on the dress by herself, then when ready staff will enter the changing room to lace/zip up and adjust for sizing.
- All dresses tried on will be steamed after each appointment, therefore reducing the number of daily appointments.
- The boutique will be fully cleaned and sanitized between appointments.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided, along with hand washing facilities.
- Temperature will be taken digitally on arrival, contactless, with your permission, the trigger point will be 37.5.
- Aprons will be provided upon request.
- The door will be locked at all times to ensure privacy and social distancing.
- All brochures, magazines and photo albums will be removed.
- Boutique staff will self-isolate if they show any symptoms and appointments will need to be rearranged.
- Customers are also expected to rearrange their appointment if they show any symptoms.
- Boutique hours may be extended or amended to accommodate longer appointments and breaks for cleaning in between appointments.
- Gloves will be worn to accept deliveries and hands washed afterwards.
- The bride and her guest enter the boutique at their own risk and understand that all reasonable steps have been taken to adhere to guidelines.
- Failure to comply with safety measures will result in the appointment being terminated.

Shopping list for becoming Covid-19 compliant

All purchased and ready to use from June 2020.

- Paper towels instead of a hand towel
- Pedal bin
- Disposable cups and spoons for refreshments
- Blue roll
- Cling film for operating the card machine, to be changed between each transaction
- Pens, one pen per bride, which the bride takes away
- Aprons
- Gloves
- Masks
- Thermometer
- Sanitizer
- Signage
