Is There a Hell? Skeptics Deny God Would Ever Make One

Many secular humanists deny the Bible because they think it is a fairy tale. Some of them refer to God as a Higher Power, something beyond science, but certainly

not a personable Jehovah or Jesus Christ. These people definitely deny a Hell, that it is in fact a fairy tale and no such place exists.

The existence of Hell in a person's mind depends on one thing: whether or nor not they believe the Bible. Hell has not been proven by science, like the flood has, but it is made as plain as day in the Bible. If you Believe your Bible, then you should believe in Hell. Luke 16:19-30 is Biblical proof that there is a Hell, and it is described by someone who went here. That is why that chapter and story by Jesus Christ is in the Bible. Many people would ask: if God is so good why would he make

Hell? The answer to that question lies in the perfect righteousness of God. God is without sin, but as Romans 3:23 states: we are sinners. If God ever let sin into Heaven it would corrupt Heaven. can save you from Hell— you can not save yourself by your works because your works will never be good enough. Most works-salvation religions never promise heaven, they only make the person hope that they might go to Heaven if they do enough good works. Grace through Jesus Christ is a promise of heaven simply by confessing and believing in Jesus Christ (Romans 10:9). Even though God can not allow sin into Heaven, and we are all sinners, God forgives our sin and places it as far as the east is from the west (Psalm 103:10-12), and we stand sinless before God. The blood of Christ is an atonement that washes away all of our sin. Even though

our flesh will continue to sin, though generally not as much as we did before we got saved, our soul can not sin because it is accompanied by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit, also known as the Holy Ghost or the Spirit of Truth, renders our souls sinless before God, and when we stand at the gates of Heaven God only sees that

sinless soul. God does not see all of our other sins.

Thank God for the power of the Holy Spirit and the work that Jesus did on the cross. If we got what we really deserved for our sins, we would get Hell and a Lake of Fire. Jesus Christ made a way for us to avoid a literal Hell where we would burn forever: just accept Him as your Savior.
