1. Div. I, Cl. 1 -1.2, Large. Victorian Celluloid mounted in metal. Try for as many colors of celluloid as possible, DFs and OMEs. Dixie Hersh \$25-15-10.
2. Div. I, Cl 6-0 + 7-0, Medium. Glass assorted, 15 from each section. Label and mount in order. WAB, \$10-6-4
3. Div. I, 6-2.4 + 7-1.4, Small. 15 Swirlbacks from each section, plus 12 free choice of either. Ronnie Wexler. \$15-10-5
4. Div. I, Cl. 6-6, + 10-0, 25 Any size. Kate Greenaway buttons. Label button name and material. Dixie Hersh \$25-15-10.
5. Div. I, Cl. 7-3.1 and Cl. 8-2, 24 Any Size. Colors assorted, specialized to opaque turquoise glass and turquoise colored glass mounted in/on metal. No transparent turquoise glass. Orange County Button Club. \$10-7-5
6. Div. I, Cl 7-4.12, Small. Overlay clear and colored glass. WAB, \$10-6-4
7. Div I Cl. 7-4.14, 30 Any size. Best assortment, to include at least one of each of the different size radiants. Label types and mount in order. See May 2013 NBS Bulletin for radiant numbers. Carolyn Boes. \$8-7-6
8. Div. I, Cl 8-0, Small. Glass mounted in metal assorted. WAB, \$10-6-4
9. Div. I, Cl. 8-2 + 10-14.1, 20 Any size. Glass mounted in/on metal, plus metal with OME, specialized to peacock eyes of blue and green color only. Long Beach Button Club. In memory of Dorothy Tunison. \$10-7-3
10. Div. I 10-13.2, 25 Any size. Specialized to French tights. Look for variety of backmarks, DF's, etc. Sacramento Button Club, \$15-10-5
11. Div. I, Cl. 11-6. 20 Any size. Shell mounted in/on metal. Los Angeles Button Club. \$10-8-7
12. Div. I, Cl. 15-1 + 15-2 + 15-3 + 15-4 + 15-5. 25 Any size. Label materials. **Judging Chair Award.** \$25-15-10
13. Div. I, Cl. 17-2 Various. Birds assorted. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15-10-5
14. Div. I, Cl. 24-0, Large. 18th Century (or earlier). **Johnnie & Louie Memorial Award** (Long Beach Button Club), \$25-15-10

15. Div. II, Section I Classes 1-3, 1-4.3 + 1-5 42 Small. Specialized to 14 each of the following: Federal government Agencies; Schools; State Militias/National Guard Companies/Regiments. Label and mount classes together. Label significant back marks. [This award allows the novice collector to use readily available small size United States buttons and gives the advanced collector an opportunity to show some great U.S. historical rarities.] **Bryce Memorial Award**. \$10-7-3
16. Div III, Cl. 1-1.3.1.3, 25 Any size, One Piece 30's. Must have at least one pictorial from the four pictorial sections. Try for an assortment of colors. Nancy Wilson, \$20-\$10-\$5.
17. Div. III, Cl. 2-0, 20 Any size. Ceramics Assorted. Long Beach Button Club, \$10-7-3
18. Div. III, Cl. 7-1.3 Small. Clear & Colored Glass Sew-thrus, specialized to opaque glass colors, including white. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15-10-5
19. Div. III, Cl. 14-2, 25 Any size. Unprocessed wood, specialized to boxwood. OME and DF allowed. Orange County Button Club. \$10-7-5
20. Div. III, Cl. 25-3.2 20 Any size. Designer logo/brand name Los Angeles Button Club. Label each designer. In memory of Pauline Lum. \$10-8-7
21. Div. IV, Cl 2-0 Buckles. 8 Any size. Specialized to enamel buckles/clasps. **Awards Chair Award**, \$25-15-10
22. Div. VII-A, Cl 20-4, 20 Any size. Cartoon, comic and commercial characters. Label character if known. WAB, \$10-6-4
23. Div. IX, CL 1-0 thru 15-5, 25 Any size. *Nouns* that begin with the letter B. Must include at least one basket. No limit on realistics. In loving memory of Janet Baer. Sonoma County Button Club, \$25-15-10
24. Div. IX, Cl 1-0 thru 15-5, Various. Assorted materials including China. No need to mount in class order, but must label material. *Limited to members who have competed 5 years or less*. San Diego Button Club, \$25-15-10.
25. Div IX, Cl. 1-3 + 12-8, 25 Any size. Celluloid and Synthetic Polymers imitating other materials. Label the other materials. Sacramento Button Club, \$15-10-5
26. Div. IX, Cl. 2-3, 20 Any size. Satsuma depicting flowers. Orange County Button Club. \$10-7-5

27. Div. IX, Cl. 5-0, 25 Any size, Fabrics/Textiles Assorted. Labelling helpful but not required. No Studios. Inland Empire Button Club, \$25-15-10.
28. Div. IX, Cl. 6-0, 24 Any size. Black Glass Assorted. Label and mount in class order. Limited to entrants who have never won a ribbon in Black Glass before. **Jane Ford Adams Memorial Award**, \$50-20-10.
29. Div. IX, Cl. 7-1, 25 Any size. Back types assorted. Mount on acetate. Long Beach Button Club, \$10-7-3
30. Div. IX, Cl 7-3, 25 Any size. Specialized to green glass. WAB, \$10-6-4
31. Div. IX, Cl 10-4.1 + 10-4.2. 25 Any size. Specialized to 10 American Indian silver, Mexican silver, 10 Hallmarked or quality marked silver and 5 free choice. Label backmarks. WAB, \$10-6-4
32. Div. IX, Cl. 12-1.1 + 12-1.3 + 12-1.4 + 12-2.2 + 12-2.4, 25 Any size. 5 amino resin, 5 phenolic resin, 5 polyester, 5 acrylic, and 5 nylon. No limit on realistics. Delores Miller. \$10-8-6
33. Div. IX, Cl. 14-0, 25 Any size. Wood. ABC Club, \$15-10-5
34. Div. IX, CL 17-0 thru 20-24 Various. Pictorials with a pirate theme or connection. Label verbally each button and how it might relate to a pirate's life. An example might be a parrot, or a palm tree on a beach scene, etc. Two realistics allowed for each pictorial section. No balance among sections and mounting in class order not required. 35. Div. IX, Cl. 17-0, 25 Any size. Animals specialized to black glass. ABC Club, \$15-10-5
36. Div. IX, Cl. 17-2, M/L. Birds specialized to assorted materials. Must have 5 of each subsection of birds. No studios. Label materials; no penalty if labeling is incorrect. L. Renee Comeau. \$15-10-5
37. Div IX, Cl. 17-2.2, 25 Any size. Materials assorted. Sacramento Button Club, \$15-10-5
38. Div. IX, Cl. 17-5.1 20 Any size. Domestic cats. In memory of Kay Earls. Los Angeles Button Club. \$10-8-7
39. Div. IX, Cl. 17-5.2, 25 Any size. Wild cats including extinct species; excluding those wearing clothes or engaged in human activities. No limit on realistics. Modesto Button Club. \$10-8-6

40. Div. IX, Cl. 17-5.6 + 18-7 25 Any size. 10 Horses (no mules, donkeys, rocking horses, etc.), and 10 horseshoes, plus 5 free choice. Riders on horses ok. Try for 25 different materials. Label anything of interest. Ronnie Wexler. \$25-15-10
41. Div. IX, Cl 18-6.3, 25 Any size, Footwear. No limit on realistics. Nancy Wilson, \$20-\$10-\$5.
42. Div. IX, Cl. 19-2.4, 25 Any size. Roses. Try for as many materials as possible. No limit on realistics. *Limited to those who have not received a blue ribbon in roses.* Modesto Button Club. \$10-8-6
43. Div. IX, Cl. 20-1, 20 Large. Architectural Structures and Scenes, 6 Architectural structures must be recognizable and labeled with structure name. Marion Nebiker. \$20- 10-5
44. Div. IX, Cl. 20-2, M/L. Asian themed buttons specialized to assorted materials. No more than 1 studio. Label materials, but no penalty if material is incorrectly identified. **Editor's Award** \$25-15-10
45. Division IX, Section 20-14, 25 any. Men in Action, Each button must show a man or men in an activity. Other figures (women or children) are allowed on the button. San Diego Button Club, \$25, 15, 10
46. Div. IX, Cl. 20-23, 20 Any size. Identifiable women. Each button must be labeled with the name of the woman. Marion Nebiker. \$20-10-5
47. Div IX, Cl. 17-1 thru 20-24, Diminutive. No balance required between pictorial sections. No limit on realistics. Recommend mounting and labeling in class order to assist judges but not required. Stylized plant life ok. Trarie Kottkamp. \$30-6-4.
48. Div. IX, Cl. 22-1 25 Any size. Patterns assorted. Limited to those who have competed five years or less. See pattern article in the NBS Bulletin, May 2009, and read the Blue Book section on patterns. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15-10-5
49. Div. IX, Cl. 22-1 25 Any size. Patterns specialized to 10 Fleur-de-lis and 10 Paisley with 5 free choice. See pattern article in the NBS Bulletin, May 2009, and read the Blue Book section on patterns. ABC Club, \$15-10-5
50. Div. IX, Cl. 23-6.5, 25 Any size. Mechanical/moveable. WAB, \$10-6-4
