**MUTUAL AGREEMENT for FUNERAL
(Pandemic Time Re-opening of Churches)**

Dear Fr. Dennis,

By signing this document, I am agreeing to the following Parish directives :

1. Incense and Pall will not be used at this time.
2. Only one picture is allowed to be put in front during mass. Collage can be displayed at the foyer or outside of the church.
3. Eulogies are not allowed at this time. Eulogy and thanking the people can be done at the cemetery.
4. Flower arrangements are allowed in limited quantity in front of the sanctuary so as not to obstruct the whole view of the altar.
5. The cup (Blood of Christ) is not given to the assembly at this time.
6. Although mask and distancing are no longer mandatory, we leave to each individual the decision to wear mask or not, to hold hands with family members and to shake hands with family members during the kiss of peace. Those who have underlying condition are encouraged to continue observing the necessary precautions.
