## FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK



### *Happy New Year!*

If you haven't received your green 2025 membership card by now, your gate key card has likely been deactivated. You will need to pay your 2025 dues plus a \$25 late fee to reactivate your gate key card.

Punxsutawney Phil forecasts an early spring. He must be right. Trout stocking will begin in March and the 2024 stocking schedule is available on the website. Check out the schedule and come out to help-- stocking trout can be a lot of fun. I have plenty of fond memories of stocking trout with my dad when I was a kid.

Our shooting sports programs also come back in full swing in March after a winter hibernation. Shooting events for the year have been scheduled, so check the club calendar. March events include a FunShoot, Multigun Match, USPSA Match, 22 PRS, and Tuesday Plate league.

Finally, a reminder about General Range Rules posted on our website which clearly state that you are required to **"Pickup and dispose of empty cases, ammunition boxes, used targets, cleaning patches, etc."** It's easy to clean up your spent cases from the cement inside the shooting pavilions on Range 2 and Range 3 – there are brooms and shovels available for this purpose. Picking up spent cases or shotgun hulls from the stone on Range 1 and the grass on Range 2 is more difficult, but please do your best to clean up after your shooting session. Keep your brass or put it in the appropriately labeled can. Shotgun hulls can go into the trash cans along with used targets. Better yet, take your trash with you and put it in the dumpster near the front gate or take it home. Your cooperation in maintaining our ranges is greatly appreciated.

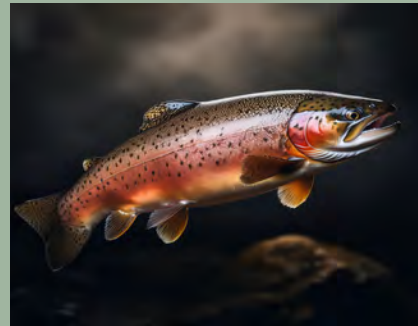

## CLUBHOUSE RENOVATION

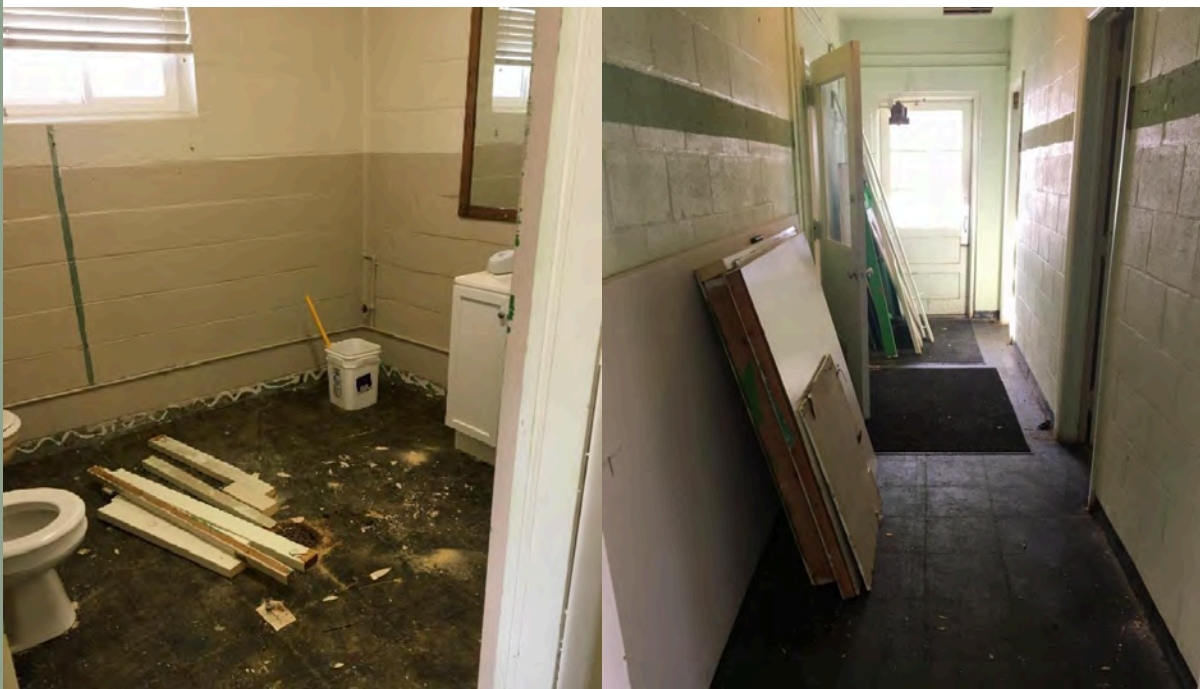
The renovation to the clubhouse Kitchen/baths is off to a successful start!

## NOMINATE A TEEN

The Wildlife Leadership Academy is currently seeking referrals of students ages 14 to 17 to become Conservation Ambassadors. Nominations are now being accepted online at [www.wildlifeleadershipacademy.org/nominate](http://www.wildlifeleadershipacademy.org/nominate). Informational packets will be mailed to nominated students, containing an invitation to apply to the 2025 program. This is the ideal summer field school for students who are interested in conservation and the outdoors!

Accepted nominees will become certified Conservation Ambassadors through attending a 5-day residential summer field schools which focuses on a particular wildlife species, including white-tailed deer, bass, brook trout, turkey and bear. Students in each field school will gain extensive knowledge about natural resource conservation, leadership experience, and communication skills.

As Conservation Ambassadors, students can receive a letter of a recommendation for college applications; certification of community service work, and continuing educational opportunities such as college visit days and attending professional conferences. Students are also eligible to apply for three college credits through Cedar Crest College, return to the Academy as a youth mentor the following year, compete for college scholarships, and join an Academy Alumni Network of wildlife, fisheries, and conservation professionals.

The mission of the Wildlife Leadership Academy is to engage and empower high school age youth to become Conservation Ambassadors to ensure a sustained wildlife, fisheries and natural resource legacy for future generations. The Academy, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, is a cooperative initiative involving state agencies and conservation organizations.
