- 8C Daily diary/journal of when tasks were completed and when they had to be rescheduled
- 9 Written project plan on paper, not necessarily a real-life project, such as, camping trip, developing a community service project, school or religious event, creating an annual patrol plan with additional activities not already included in the troop plan
- 10A Research on a career choice - limitation, education, skills, experience and so on - Additional concepts can be discussed in person.
