Ephesians 3:20

Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us.

The word "abundant", or some variation, is used frequently throughout the scriptures and can be found from Genesis to Revelation. Sometimes it is talking about an abundance of water or cautioning about putting your trust in the abundance of possession. Other times the word abundant is referring to the gifts of God such as abundant hope, abundant love, abundant grace, or abundant mercy. The word abundant means plentiful or having more than is needed. Today I wanted to remind you that being Easter people means we believe in the God of abundance, the God without limits, the God of birth and creation. We believe that we can do all things through Christ who strengthens us!

But before we get to deep into the abundance that God offers, I want to provide for you a quarterly checkup on the missional progress our church family has been doing so far this year. You may remember that last year, 2022, was a great year for missional giving at MUP. For the first time in memory the church more than tithed its annual budget in mission giving. This is mission funds that were sent out into the community or around the world. This does not include the 'mission' that we do 'in house' through bible studies, Sunday school, Myschool Preschool, worship services, church events, etc. Mission giving last year was up almost twenty five percent over 2021! In short last year MUP did a great job of being a missional church.

As we entered this year the stewardship and mission committees discussed a desire to keep the momentum going. However, they realized there are some real challenges to that goal. We knew that this year would see a significant increase in building expenses in a variety of ways. The utilities at the church have seen a major increase. There are a number of building projects that have been discussed and there are a few large projects that may be on the horizon. With the major expense of potentially pursuing a new parking lot as well as already approved projects like replacing the trim in the church social room, painting the front of the sanctuary, and remodeling the lady's room on the first floor; there are major expenses being allocated to maintaining and enhancing our building. So far this year we have already spent/approved expenditures of over six thousand dollars for building projects. The fear has always been that when spending increases on building maintenance and improvements it might take away from the progress we have been making in being a missional church. I am over joyed to share that so far this year, that has not been the case. Our missional giving so far this year is right around ten thousand dollars! This is a forty percent increase compared to the first quarter of last year! We have done this while staying on track with our budgeting goals.

Friends, this is what it means to believe in the abundance of our God. Many church leaders I speak to have remarked about the tightening of purse strings due to economic uncertainty. But you all have trusted God; and have committed yourselves, your time, your talents, and your treasure to the good work being done by this covenant community of believers. This isn't to claim that there is an endless amount of resources or to promote some watered-down version of the prosperity gospel. This is a thank you for the faithfulness of this congregation who is living into the good news of God's abundance. As a congregation we will continue to do our due diligence in using the resources God has entrusted to our care, and together we will continue to grow the circle of love that is emanating from Mars UP. Thank You for trusting God! Thank you for your generosity! Thank God that we are Easter people who receive abundant grace!

New Mevo Cameras

The church purchased a Mevo Camera starter pack with the hope of improving our audio and visual display for recorded worship services. The new system provides three cameras that allow us to utilize various camera angels as well as a picture in picture option to display the words to songs while still viewing worship leaders. A unique feature of this system is that we are able to plug our sound system directly into the audio output so those watching our services on Facebook will receive a higher quality sound without all of the background noise that exists in the sanctuary.
