Membership is coming along great keep up the good work. We will be hitting 100% mark soon. Let's keep building new members.


Our meeting dates are February 17th and March 16 at 7pm. This is Burger night, come down for dinner and then the meeting.

February 8<sup>th</sup>, will be Jam night check post for time.


February 14<sup>th</sup>, Steak night and Love will be in the air with Valentines drink specials and sweets for your sweetie.


